

Scholarship Frequently Asked Questions

- **Can I submit a paper copy of my application?**
 - Paper copies are no longer accepted. All applications must be submitted through the online application to be considered.
- **Do I need to reapply?**
 - Scholarships that require reapplying:
 - Arthur K. Woodman Scholarship
 - Florida College Transfer Academic Scholarship
 - Florida College Transfer Scholarships
 - Gulf Power Scholarship
- **What are the deadlines?**
 - All deadlines are listed by the individual scholarship. No late applications will be accepted.
- **How does my reference submit their letter?**
 - Please submit their email address, your reference will receive a code and instructions on how to upload a PDF of their letter. Letters must be on official letterhead.
- **How do I submit my transcripts?**
 - PDFs of official or unofficial transcripts can be uploaded to the application. The upload must be legible. The transcripts will be used by the selection committee to make their decisions. All information will be verified. If a student provides inaccurate information, they will become ineligible for the scholarship.
- **If I drop below full time, will I lose my scholarship?**
 - All of the scholarships require students to be enrolled full-time or more. If a student does not enroll in at least 12 credits (14 for FCTAS), the scholarship will not be disbursed. If you are a student in your final semester and therefore taking less than 12 credits, you must contact the Office of Undergraduate Affairs to let them know.
